## Board of Directors Meeting 6:30 p.m. Tuesday March 1st, 2022

**Approval of minutes:** Steve Worden moved to approve the minutes: second Clinton Means – motion approved.

## **New Business:**

- (a) Operations Manager Report: Stated work has been busy working both dispatch and administrations, but all is good.
- **(b) Deputy Director's Report:** Is busy with several tasks. The main job is mapping and addressing, checking road names, and correction/rectifying road ranges. Doddridge County is almost complete then will start in Ritchie County.
- (c) Executive Directors Report:

This budget for 2022-23 uses the income from the Profit and Loss statement for 2020-21. This produces a positive balance of \$217,660. Adjustments were made on line items with the majority of these items remain the same. One adjustment was to increase the Repair and Maintenance to \$30,000. We need to replace the Key Card lock systems in the buildings. We have tried but have not gotten an estimate on this.

This budget includes a .75 a crossed the board raise. With the exception of Sean Reed which will be \$1.00 after training. This brings all Dispatchers to at least \$15.00 per hour.

It would also do away with the 20 year cap on longevity pay.

It would also create (10) ten (8) hour holidays per year. New Year's Day, President Day, Easter, Memorial Day, 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.
