New Business: (a) 2023-2024 Budget

This budget for 2023-24 uses the income from the Profit and Loss statement for 2023. This produces a positive balance of \$147,851.

This year the COLA is 8.7%. This year I would like to structure the pay for Dispatchers like other Counties. **See attached.**

This would still include the .50 cent difference for night shift, .25 cents for the training officer position. I would also like to create the Technical Assistant position with a \$1.00 increase above their Dispatch rate which can increase with their knowledge and ability. It also includes the 8.7% for the other positions.
